Hereby presented is the Seminar entitled “**Socioeconomic and Environmental Valuation of Industrial Areas Redevelopment**” that takes place on the **11th June 2013**, following the conclusion of the REHMINE Project, and to which we would like to extend you an invitation.

The main objective of the project REHMINE was to value a rural brownfield redevelopment based on the principles of sustainable development, in particular the integration of the interests of the social players involved. For this, we studied the potential redevelopment planning of Mina de São Domingos in Mértola, Portugal (<http://pascal.iseg.utl.pt/~socius/rehmine/>).

The Seminar is structured in two parts. The first will present the results of the 3 years REHMINE’s research. The second part will focus on research and practice on industrial rehabilitation and redevelopment, and public policies in Portugal and EU. This program allows for: an exchange of experiences within the brownfield redevelopment in Portugal and EU, and promote knowledge about industrial heritage, mining industry, contaminated soil remediation and reflecting on the main challenges and needs.
